


New Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs

- Some proposals were sent to panels last week
- Recommendations for revision or clarification went out last week to the appropriate EPP
- Background summaries for posting of proposals recommended for approval are currently being completed
- A few new proposals have been completed and are working their way through the signature process



Spring review cycle

- Programs up for review this spring should be submitted by March 15th using current forms
- Will continue with hybrid approach using panels to complete reviews.

Ed Prep Program Review Redesign Update

- Will implement fully 1-year after endorsement from SUED and OAPCTE – first all program review submission
 - Calendar for state reviews CAEP currently contacting
 - Aligned to CAEP site visits 2 years prior
 - Incorporation of 2-year program review and community college representation
 - Transition plan
 - How to address programs needing review prior to scheduled state review



Ed Prep Program Review Redesign Update

- A manual similar to CCGS manual to include bylaws, processes, and forms.
 - Common elements report draft being presented at Accreditation coordinators meeting
 - reviewed by Chancellor's Council for Educator Preparation Programs (CCEPP)
 - Program report draft being presented at Accreditation coordinators meeting
 - reviewed by faculty panels
- Possible to start use of new forms in fall 21, decision in March in collaboration with SUED and OAPCTE

Program Review Redesign Update

- Other elements we are working on
 - Video conference option with faculty panels and program personnel
 - Crosswalk development for each program to demonstrate curriculum and assessments align to national standards
 - Presentation of new forms at Accreditation Coordinators meeting will be recorded to share

Intervention Specialist dual licensure programs

- Advisory committee made up of Deans Compact leadership
 - Three working committees developed program standards
 - Posted for public comment
 - Dual PK-5 IS
 - Dual Middle Childhood IS
 - Dual Adolescent Young Adult IS
